
Project Update - City Building

- Initial work is focused on evaluating the potential costs of basic improvements such as roof, windows, HVAC, etc.


Project Update - Town Center Parking Study

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



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

Project Update – Rt. 8

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


Project Update - Grand Avenue Road Diet & Roundabout

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










Project Update – Zoning Code & Subdivision Regulations
