ORDINANCE O-04-2020

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE O-16-2013 ADOPTED ON OCTOBER 7, 2014 AND ORDINANCE O-19-2013 ADOPTED ON JANUARY 21, 2014, CODIFIED IN CHAPTER 111.04 BY CHANGING THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEES FOR QUOTA RETAIL DRINK LICENSE AND NQ-2 RETAIL DRINK LICENSE FOR THE CITY OF FORT THOMAS, CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, during the 2019 Legislative Session the Kentucky General Assembly, through Senate Bill _____, adopted amendments to Kentucky Revised Statutes Chapters 241 to 244 regarding alcoholic beverage annual fees; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF FORT THOMAS, CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

That Title XI, Business Regulation, Chapter 111, Alcoholic Beverages, Section 111.04 (A)(3) and Section 111.04 (A)(7) of the Fort Thomas Code of Ordinances relating to annual license fees for the sale of alcoholic beverages is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 111.04 LICENSE CLASSIFICATIONS; ANNUAL FEES

(A)(3) Quota retail drink license. A quota retail drink license shall authorize the licensee to purchase, receive, possess, and sell distilled spirits and wine at retail by the drink for consumption on the licensed premises. A quota retail drink license shall not authorize the sale of distilled spirits or wine by the package. The license fee shall be \$1,000 \$850 per annum.

(A)(7)(a) NQ-2 retail drink license. A NQ-2 retail drink license shall authorize the licensee to purchase, receive, possess, and sell distilled spirits, wine and malt beverages at retail by the drink for consumption on the licensed premises. A NQ-2 retail drink license shall not authorize the sale of distilled spirits, wine or malt beverages by the package. The license fee shall be \$1,000 \$850 per annum.

SECTION II

All ordinances, resolutions or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, are to the extent of such conflict hereby repealed.

SECTION III

That this Ordinance shall be in effect, when read, passed, and published according to law.
