

**ORDINANCE NO. O-15-2020**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 75, SCHEDULE III  
OF THE CITY OF FORT THOMAS CODE OF ORDINANCES,  
BY SETTING THE SPEED LIMIT FOR GLENWAY AVENUE.**

WHEREAS, a traffic study has been completed in regard to the speed limit on Glenway Avenue; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Fort Thomas, has determined that the public safety would be served by establishing a speed limit of fifteen (15) miles per hour on Glenway Avenue;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF FORT THOMAS, CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY:

**SECTION I**

Section 75, Schedule III of the City Code of Ordinances, shall be amended as follows:

**SCHEDULE III: SPEED LIMITS.**

Inasmuch as there are too many traffic accidents and fatalities, many caused by excessive speed, the majority of the streets in the city, with the exception of the few through streets shown in Chapter 75, Schedule II above, short, dead end, narrow streets, many with steep grades, curves, and no sidewalks, it is deemed advisable to reduce the speed permitted by state law. Therefore, in accordance with §71.21, the prima facie speed limit shall be 25 miles per hour on all streets in the city, except the following streets or portions of streets where the speed limit shall be as shown below.

**SECTION II**

All ordinances, resolutions or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, are to the extent of such conflict hereby repealed.
