## ORDINANCE NO. O-05-2022

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND MODIFYING THE FINE SCHEDULE SET FORTH IN CITY OF FORT THOMAS ORDINANCE O-05-2018, SECTION 34.13, SO AS TO REPLACE SAID ORDINANCE AS FOLLOWS:

Violations of ordinances that are enforced by the assigned hearing officer shall be subject to the following schedule of civil fines:

## **SECTION I**

(A) If a citation for a violation of an ordinance is not contested by the person charged with the violation, the penalties set forth in this subsection shall apply:

Boats, Trailers, Recreational Vehicles & Oversized Vehicles	\$100	\$200	<u>\$500</u>
Downspouts, Driveways & Storm Water Connections	\$100	\$200	\$500
Inoperable Vehicle	\$100	\$200	<u>\$500</u>
Miscellaneous Refuse	\$100	\$200	<u>\$500</u>
Property Maintenance Code	\$100	\$200	<u>\$500</u>
Unsightly Vegetation	\$100	\$200	<u>\$500</u>
Zoning Code	\$100	\$200	<u>\$500</u>
Swimming Pools	\$100	\$200	<u>\$500</u>

## **SECTION II**

(B) If the citation is contested and a hearing before the assigned hearing officer is required, the following maximum penalties may be imposed at the discretion of the Code Enforcement Board or hearing officer:

Boats, Trailers, Recreational Vehicles & Oversized Vehicles	\$200	\$400	<u>\$1,000</u>

Inoperable Vehicle	\$200	\$400	<u>\$1,000</u>
Miscellaneous Refuse	\$200	\$400	\$1,000
Property Maintenance Code	\$200	\$400	\$1,000
Unsightly Vegetation	\$200	\$400	<u>\$1,000</u>
Zoning Code	\$200	\$400	<u>\$1,000</u>
Swimming Pools	\$200	\$400	<u>\$1,000</u>

## **SECTION III**
