## *December 2022 Monthly Report Summary*

### **COMMUNITY EVENTS**

Campbell County FOP Lodge #10 hosted the 28th annual ***Cops and Kids Event***. The Lodge continued its efforts this year to provide students in the county with extra Christmas gifts they otherwise may not receive. Over 2,000 children have benefitted from the FOP's efforts through the program's history. Local schools help identify students around the county who would most benefit from the program. On Saturday, December 10th, the children met Officers at the Newport Elks in Cold Spring for breakfast, then traveled to Meijer in Cold Spring and shopped from 8 a.m. to 10 a.m. The children and their gifts returned to Newport Elks, where a team of Santa's helpers wrapped gifts while the kids enjoyed lunch. Fort Thomas Officers Zac Rohlfers, Nick Hoffman and Geoff Lucas donated their time to support this event. Donations for this cause are accepted year-round.

### **TRAINING**

Officer Nick Hoffman attended ***Crime Scene Investigations***. This five-day (40 hour) Crime Scene Investigation course is intended for crime scene investigators/technicians, forensic technicians and detectives/investigators in the early stages of their career. This hands-on course is designed to familiarize law enforcement personnel with the basic technical skills needed to identify, document, preserve and collect the most common types of physical evidence found at crime scenes. Attendees will participate in numerous practical exercises to establish baseline knowledge in everything from crime scene documentation and photography to collecting various types of evidence for additional laboratory processing. Attendees will also be given an opportunity to learn fingerprint and latent print processing techniques utilizing a variety of chemicals and forensic light sources.

Officers completed ***Vehicle Operations Training***. The training was conducted at the DAV parking lot in Cold Spring. Officers completed various vehicle operation skills such as ABS breaking, backing, trailing edge, and straight line breaking. Instruction of how to best conduct "high risk" (or felony) traffic stops and demonstrate policy compliant vehicle operations during a mock pursuit to include radio traffic, siren/light operation and secondary vehicle responsibilities.

All Officers completed the mandatory Taser X26P CEW V.22 User Certification Course.

## **MISCELLANEOUS:**

The Fort Thomas Police Department extends a thank you to our residents for stopping and saying hello, sending cards or dropping off treats during the holiday season.

## **ENFORCEMENT:**

In December officers wrote 17 speeding charges, 16 charges for non-traffic offenses (i.e., warrants, assaults, disorderly conduct, etc.) and 39 traffic related charges (i.e., suspended OL, no insurance, expired license plate, etc.) Officers also issued 24 written warnings and totaled 28 court appearances. There were 7 drug related charges placed against 3 adults and 1 drug related charge placed against 1 juvenile. One of the individuals is a Fort Thomas resident. Traffic stops led to all of the charges.
