May 2023 Monthly Report Summary

COMMUNITY EVENTS:



School Resource Officer Zac Rohlfer talked to the 5th graders of all three elementary schools, Johnson, Woodfill, and Moyer about the Bill of Rights. They discussed in length how the amendments in the Bill of Rights direct policing and relate to the laws that govern our society every day. The students were able to ask questions and they came up with some incredibly interesting ones. Overall, it was a great way for them to see how something they read about that was formed so long ago still matters in their lives to this day.



Crime Scene Investigations (CSI) was brought back this year by the FTPD and Saint Thomas School. Twenty students participated in the elective program once per week during the time frame of February thru May. All participants received a Certificate of Completion. Thank you to Lieutenant Adam Noe for not only coordinating the program but also providing instruction to the students. Detective Brandon Vance assisted in several weeks of presenting to the students.

Officer Brad Reichenbach attended *Strategies & Tactics of Patrol Stops Instructor*. Police Officers engage in deploying from patrol vehicles numerous times every shift. Studies have shown this is one of the most dangerous duties of an Officer. The STOPS course will provide Officers with the tactics to recognize threat cues and concepts. They will leave with a superior skill set to counter felonious and accidental assaults. This mental and physical skill set provides a safer tour of duty for the Officer and all other Officers they later train.

ENFORCEMENT:

In May officers wrote 15 speeding charges, 10 charges for non-traffic offenses (i.e., warrants, assaults, disorderly conduct, etc.) and 59 traffic related charges (i.e., suspended OL, no insurance, expired license plate, etc.) Officers also issued 59 written warnings and totaled 21 court appearances. There were 15 drug related charges placed against 8 adults. One of the individuals is a Fort Thomas resident. Traffic stops led to 10 of the charges.
