January 2024 Monthly Report Summary

TRAINING:

Officer Joe Paolucci attended Law Enforcement Training Officer. The Law Enforcement Training Officer program presents post academy training with a focus on problem solving, leadership, adult-learning principles, emotional intelligence, generational differences, mentoring and coaching, legal liability, stress and wellness, and scenario based training. The course provides instruction to potential training officers on the management and administration aspects of conducting a post academy training program for recent academy graduates, as well as, lateral transfer officers and addresses safety concerns that training officers should stress to new officers.

Officer Nicholas Hoffman attended Leadership is a Behavior. This is a 40-hour course for non-supervisory Peace Officers and Investigators. This course is centered on leadership and influencing behavior(s) from the individual Peace Officer's perspective. Officers and Investigators seeking promotion, coaching, mentoring, field training, and Police Training Officer responsibilities within their agencies will benefit from the application of the coursework.

Bulleit's drive to succeed and happy demeanor were the primary factors that influenced Officer French's decision. The four weeks consisted of narcotic detection, article searches, and scent tracking. The days were long and the weather was cold but K9 Bulleit excelled throughout the entire course. Officer French and K9 Bulleit are now a nationally certified K9 team capable of tracking lost or missing people, finding lost or dropped items, and locating narcotics.

K9 Bulleit is ready to work and alerted during a traffic stop on 471, yielding a plethora of drug paraphernalia and a small amount of meth. Good boy Bulleit!!!

ENFORCEMENT:

In January officers wrote 22 speeding charges, 26 charges for non-traffic offenses (i.e., warrants, assaults, disorderly conduct, etc.) and 99 traffic related charges (i.e., suspended OL, no insurance, expired license plate, etc.) Officers also issued 133 written warnings and totaled 20 court appearances. There were 25 drug related charges.
